- 4 Launch of an ITINERANT REGIONAL FESTIVAL to be held annually in one of the sites,
- 5 Planning of an ADRION NETWORKS OF PATHS for bikers, integrating equestrian and trekking routes,
- 6 Creation of a shared PLATFORM FOR PROFESSIONAL TRAINING COURSES for tourist and cultural operators, for firms of the service sector, associations and for policy-makers,
- 7 Support of a NETWORK OF THIRD SECTOR ACTORS (culture, environment, heritage, recreation, sport)
- 8 Identification of potential 'PRODUCT CLUBS' on the model of Principato Landi www.principatolandi.it
- 9 Design of INNOVATIVE TOURIST 'PRODUCTS' (Literary Parks, Eco-Museums, tourist and sport packages, Adriatic-Ionian cruises and regattas) to make them interact with the existing offer,
- 10 TECHNICAL SUPPORT to cities, towns or sub-regions and protected areas to define and achieve the UNESCO candidacy to be included in the UNESCO list of World Heritage sites or UNESCO MAB reserve,
- 11 Creation of a PORTFOLIO OF PROJECTS for every partner to be submitted to other EU programmes.
