THE TOWN OF KOTOR



- Situated on the southeast end of Boka Bay, Kotor entered the list of the World cultural and natural Heritage under the protection of the UNESCO
- As the only fjord on the Mediterranean, Boka Bay was added to the list of 25 most beautiful bays in the world
- The region is under a strong influence of medditerranean climate. The lowest temperature of sea is 10° C
- Kotor has been one of the most important trading center throughout history and nowadays is a prestigious cruising port in this part of the Adriatic sea
- Boka Bay consists of four small bays with the narrowest section, Verige, 300m distance straight from shore to shore



In recent years, Kotor has seen a steady increase in tourists, many of them coming by cruise ship. We have a privillege of being Top cruising destination in the Mediterranean






The only fjord on the Mediterranean




- From 2006 Port of Kotor has specialized in providing services in maritime tourism and after 10 years has become one of the most popular destinations in Europe. As a first cruising port in Montenegro we are honored to be **port of national interest.**
- In 2016: 488 calls and more than 500 000 passengers as a result of enormous transfer from East Mediterannean
- In 2017: 430 calls and 532,387 passengers
- 3rd port in Adriatic Sea and 5th in Mediterranean Sea pax movements
- Gold member of Cruise Line International Association
- Port Member in MEDCruise Association

• Extending main cruise season in winter months


(cultural, historical and religious tourism)

- Environmental awareness










Project of two mooring buoys

- Security and safety berthing
- Lower risk of weather changes
- Environmental protection, gas emission
- Extend cruising season in winter months



Expansion of marina capacity is currently in progress. We have already installed breakwater which is 60m long. In next phase (until the end of 2018) we are planning to install two new pontons which are supposed to be finished before beginning of the next season.
