#EURegionsWeek!


The European Week of Regions and Cities (#EURegionsWeek), the biggest annual Brussels-based event dedicated to cohesion policy, is about to start!

Project "EUSAIR – Bringing the Green Deal to the Region"

The European Green Deal is about improving the well being of people. Making Europe climate-neutral and protecting our natural habitat will be good for people, planet and economy. The <u>EUSAIR</u> community, through its governance and stakeholders, sets the tone on many important political files in the Adriatic-Ionian region. It shall therefore take the lead to **make Europe climate-neutral by 2050 a reality**.

The project in question foresees the consultation of the key implementers and main stakeholders EUSAIR of the 9 countries. It will analyse the way events were organised during the pre-covid period and it will develop monitoring systems and guidelines to organise sustainable events once the sanitary emergency will be over.

AIC Forum is the coordinator of the project and cooperates for its implementation with the <u>T33 agency</u> and with the <u>University of Padua</u>.
